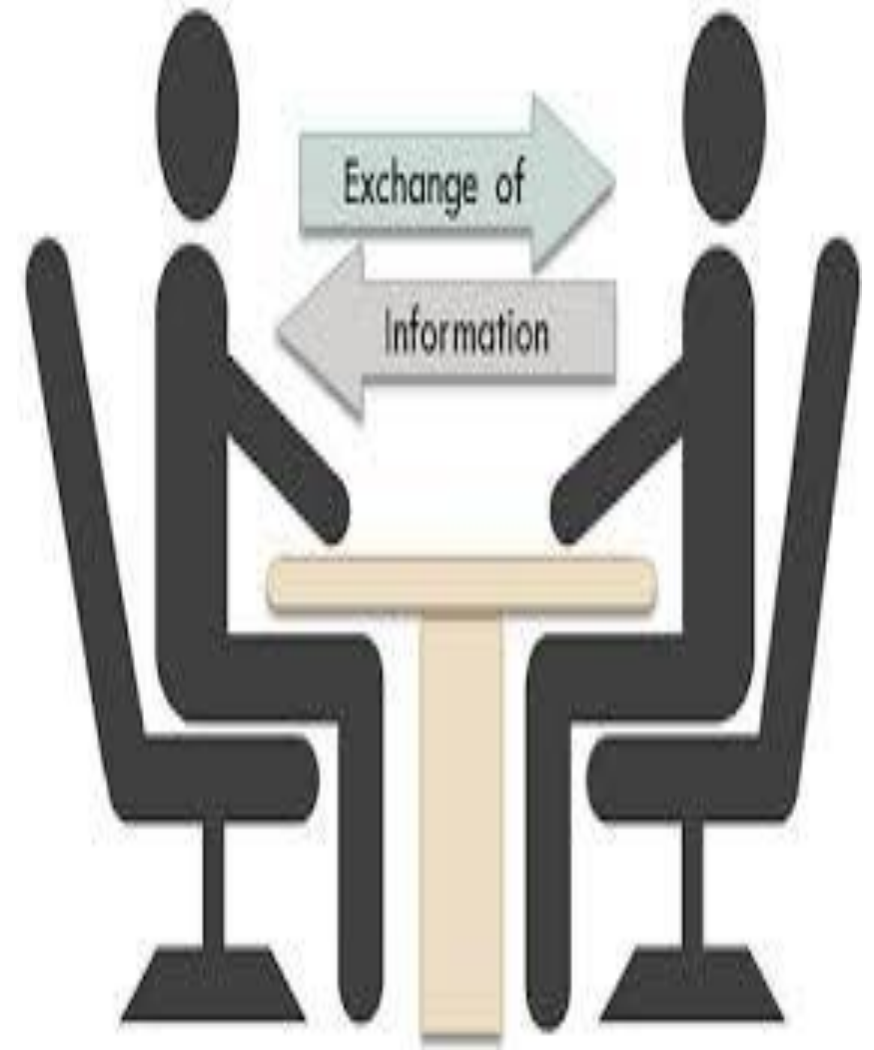

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# What is communication?

- **Communication is the sending and receiving of messages and information.**
- **For example, when we meet someone, and talk to them, we are communicating.**
- **Communication can therefore, be spoken, written or even visual.**



- **Communication can be of two types - personal communication and mass communication.**
- **PERSONAL COMMUNICATION**
- **Communication that takes place between two or a few people is called personal communication.**
- **Communicating through letters and the telephone are examples of personal communication.**



# Postal System

These letters are then carried by road, rail, air or water transport to different cities and countries.  
For the letter to reach safely, we must write the complete address along with the PIN code.

**PIN CODE- 751032**

**PIN- Postal Index Number**

## The Telephone

- Personal communication became faster when the telephone was invented by Alexander Graham Bell more than 100 years ago.
- With the telephone, people could connect to anyone anywhere in the world in a matter of seconds.



## Cellular phones

- Cellular phones are wireless telephones. They are not attached to a wire, so we can carry them anywhere we go.
- Cellular phones are also known as mobile phones.
- We can also send instant messages or SMS ( short Message Service)



# Fax Machine

Written messages can be sent instantly through a fax machine.
