MASS COMMUNICATION



- The exchange of information with many people at the same time is called mass communication.
- The means of mass communication are called mass media.

Newspapers and magazines

- Newspapers and magazines contain news, articles and advertisements printed on paper.
- They are a popular and useful means of sharing information with a large number of people every day



Radio

- The radio was one of the earliest means of mass communication. It is popular even today.
- It can be used to spread information to every corner of the country- even distant villages that do not have electricity.
- Even people who cannot read or write can listen to the radio and get information.

Television

- Today, television is one of the most popular means of mass communication. It is an audio-visual means of communication.
- We can watch movies, cartoons and news on television sitting at home. We can watch events "live' on television-that is, we can watch an event even as it is happening in some other part of the world.





Smartphones




- Smartphones are mobile phones that have the features of both a phone and a computer.
