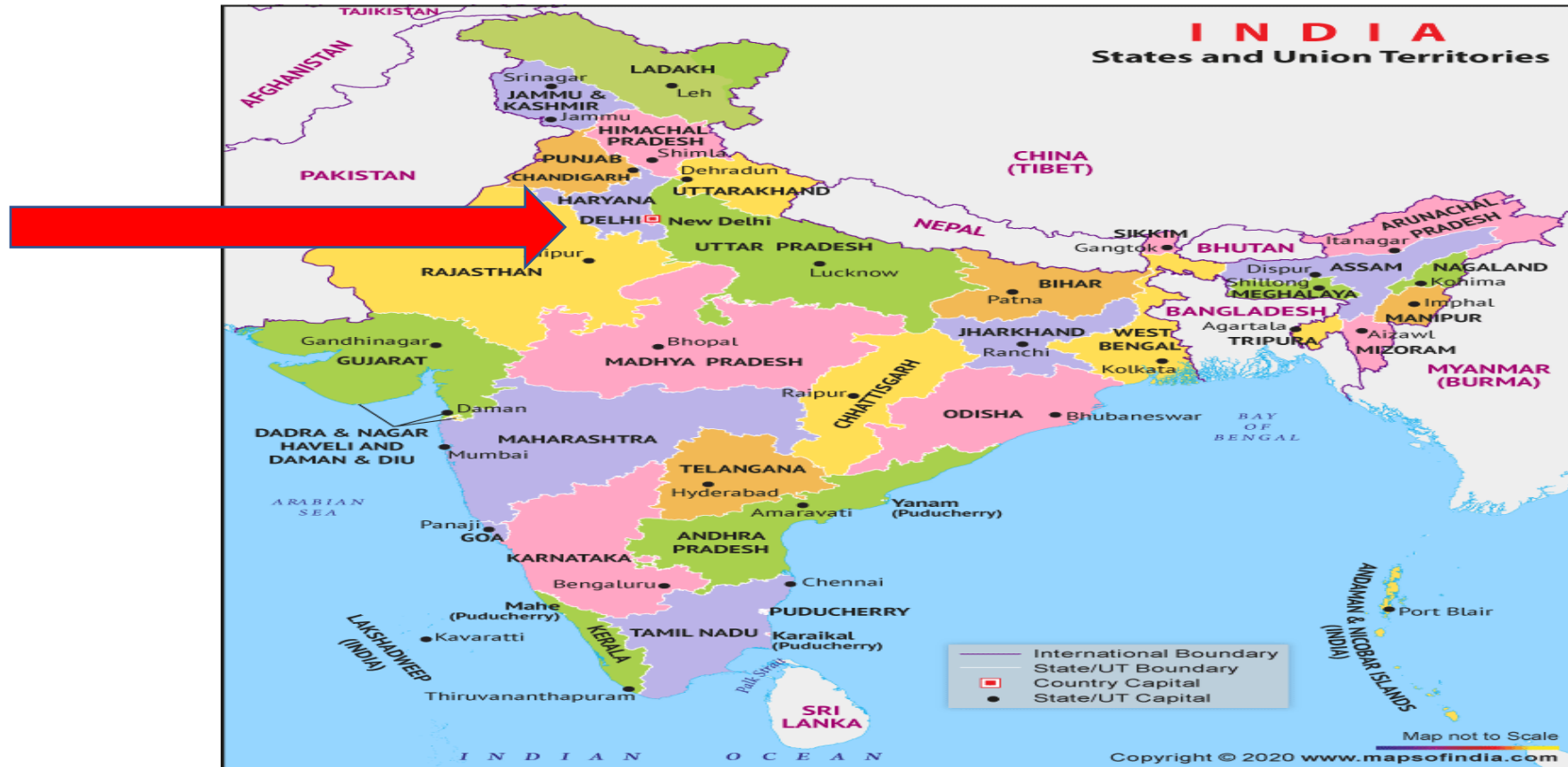

Word Meanings

1. **City:** a large, heavily populated human settlement, where most of the people work in offices and factories, rather than in farms.
2. **Culture:** the beliefs and traditions of a group of people; the music, art, literature and dance forms created by the people.
3. **Monument:** something built in the past and of great importance to the people of the country, for example, an old fort or a palace or a statue.
4. **Metro-** an under ground railway system.
5. **Hoist-** pull up a flag on a flagpole
6. **Samadhi-** structure built in memory of a person
7. **Extreme-** Highest level
