1. Where is Delhi located?

Ans- Delhi is located on the banks of the River Yamuna. It is bordered by Uttar Pradesh in the east and Haryana on the other three sides.

2. Which are the two parts that make up Delhi? How are they different?

Ans-Delhi consists of Old Delhi and New Delhi. Old Delhi was built and ruled by the Delhi sultans and the Mughuls. New Delhi was built by the British.

3. Where does the President of India live?

Ans- The President of India lives in the Rashtrapati Bhavan.

4. Mention some of the tourist attractions of Delhi.

Ans- The Red Fort, Jama Masjid, the Qutb Minar, India Gate and Raj Ghat.

Ans- People from all states of India live in Delhi. So you can see people wearing all kinds of clothes in Delhi. Most men in Delhi wear trousers and shirts. Most women wear sari or salwar-kameez.
