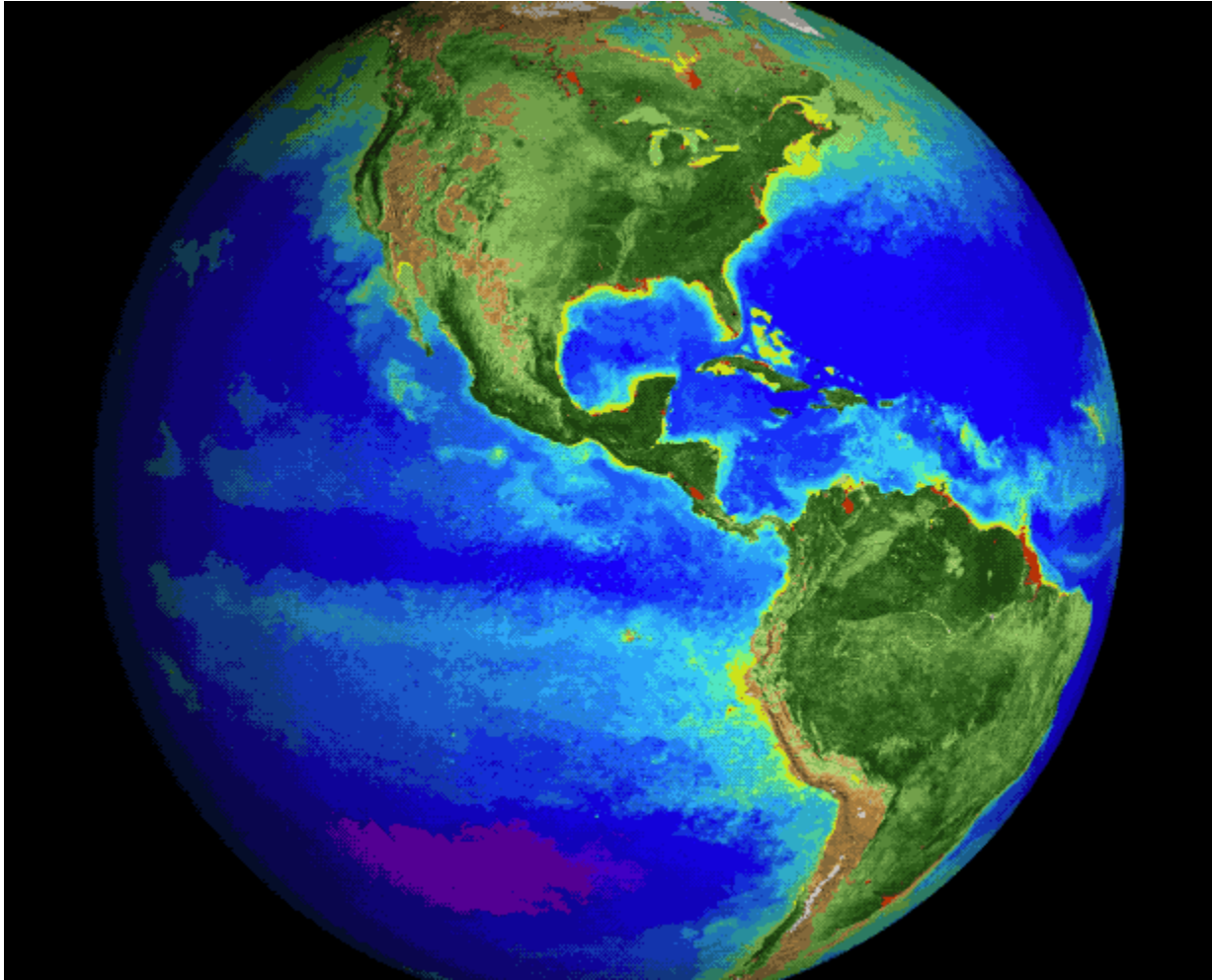
# Where do we live

# GLOBE



- **Globe is a man made three dimensional model of Earth.**
- **Globe shows the exact position of continent, country, ocean seas**
- **We can rotate to see the different places.**
- **However globe is not big enough to show all the places detail.**

# MAPS

- Maps are two dimensional representation of globe.
- A map is a representation or a drawing of the earth's surface, or a part of it, on a flat surface.
- It could be hand drawn or printed.
- It helps us identify the places and locations within an area helping us to navigate from one place to another.

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
- **An atlas is a book of maps.**
