# ADVERBS OF TIME

Jane must **eat** dinner **early**.

↓  
verb

↓  
adverb of time



**An *adverb* is a word that describes a verb, an adjective or another adverb.**

**Examples:**

- a. She speaks *slowly*.
- b. He is *so* smart.
- c. They come *very* often.

**Adverbs tell:**

**HOW (manner)**

**WHEN (time)**

**WHERE (place)**



# adverbs of manner

## Adverbs of manner



He walks **quickly**



My sister speaks **loudly**.



My grandmother is old .she walks **slowly**



Shshsh, you must **spea** **quietly**.



She paints **beautifully**.



She dances **gracefully**.





# Adverbs of Place

Adverbs that tell us where an action happens are called adverbs of place.

Example-

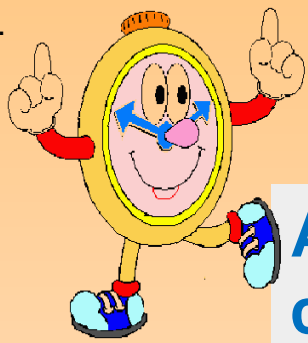

# Adverbs of Time

Adverbs that tell us **when** an action happens are called adverbs of time.

Example-

1. Let us go to the park **today**.
2. We must wake up **now**.
3. I met her **yesterday**.
4. I will eat the litchis **later**.
5. He **never** goes out with his friends.





# Adverbs of Time.

Adverbs of time explains 'WHEN' an action happens.



The above adverbs help us know **when** Thud's party is.

eventually	yet
since	when
for	while
one year	yesterday
two days	tomorrow
three weeks	ago
