Adverbs of Time

Adverbs that tell us when an action happens are called adverbs of time.

Example-

- 1.Let us go to the park today.
- 2.We must wake up now.
- 3.I met her yesterday.
- 4.I will eat the litchis later.
- 5.He never goes out with his friends.









Adverbs of Time.

Adverbs of time explains 'WHEN' an action happens.


