


Let's Recapitulate....

An *adverb* is a word that describes a verb, an adjective or another adverb.

Examples:

- a. She speaks slowly.
- b. He is so smart.
- c. They come very often.



Adverbs tell:

-How? (Manner)



- -Where?(Place)
- -When?(Time)







Adverbs of Place

Adverbs of place tell us where actions happen.

Examples- 1. Don't go outside.





Adverbs of Time

Adverbs of time change or qualify the meaning of a sentence by telling us when an action happens.

These adverbs always answer one important question: When???



- · The train has already left.
- We moved into our new house <u>last week</u>.

 Our favorite T.V. program starts <u>at 6'o clock</u>.
- I'm going to my new school tomorrow

 She stayed at her grandmother's house all day
- <u>Later</u> Robin Hood stole the king's crown


