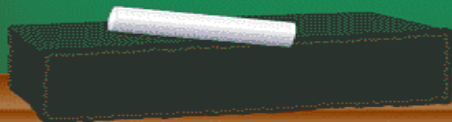
LEARNING OBJECTIVE

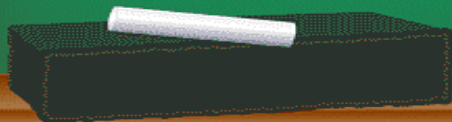

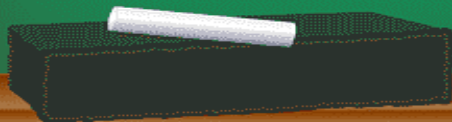
