A possessive pronoun is a pronoun that is used to indicate possession or ownership.

- This pen is my pen, not your pen.
- This pen is mine, not yours.



MINE

This is my laptop. It's mine.


Possessive Adjectives



- Possessive adjectives are used to express the idea of belonging and possession.
- My house means the house belonging to me, Your homework means the homework you are doing.
- We use possessive adjectives before nouns: my book his exam their car
