

Strong adjectives are more expressive than normal adjectives and are used with adverbs like really or absolutely. EXAMPLES OF WEAK AND STRONG ADJECTIVES

- Happy- thrilled
- Hot boiling
- Hungry starving
- Ugly awful
- Bad terrible


