- ★ The Ganga is fed by many tributaries like Alaknanda, Mandakini and Bhagirathi in the mountains.
- ★ It enters in the plains flows slowly.
- ★ Then it joins with other tributaries like Yamuna, kosi, Gandak, Ghagra, Gomti.
- ★ After flowing through Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, it enters West Bengal.
- **★** It distribute itself into two branches.
- ★ The Hooghly flows through Kolkata and Padma flows through Bangladesh.
- ★ Padma mixes with Brahmaputra and all the rivers make a delta and flows into the Bay of Bengal.
