
The Preamble, or introduction, to our Constitution describes India as a democratic, socialist, secular republic.











PREAMBLE

WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA,

having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC

REPUBLIC and to secure to all its citizens:

JUSTICE, social, economic and political;

LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship;

EQUALITY of status and of opportunity;

and to promote among them all

FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and

the unity and integrity of the Nation;

IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this 26th day of

November, 1949, do HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE

TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.




I have read the Preamble



Socialist

- This means that all the people in the country will be treated as equals.
- The government will not differentiate between people on the basis of their caste, religion or in any other way. This is known as the principle of socialism.




DEMOCRATIC

- This means that all the people of the country will choose or elect leaders who would form the government.
- This kind of government is known as democracy.
- Our country is no longer ruled by kings.

If the people are not happy with their elected leaders, they can be removed from their posts.







SECULAR

 This means that all people in the country would be free to follow whatever religion they want. This is known as the principle of secularism.



REPUBLIC

 This means that our head of state is elected by the people.

 India is headed by an elected president, unlike Britain whose head of state is a hereditary monarch.
