

#### **SECULAR**

 This means that all people in the country would be free to follow whatever religion they want. This is known as the principle of secularism.





## **REPUBLIC**

 This means that our head of state is elected by the people.

 India is headed by an elected president, unlike Britain whose head of state is a hereditary monarch.

# **Our Fundamental Rights**

 The Constitution of India gives its citizens certain fundamental rights.

 If anyone feels that his or her fundamental rights have been denied, he or she can approach a court of law.





# Some of the important fundamental rights are

# given here:

- Right to equality
- Right to freedom of speech-we can speak freely without fear.
- Right to follow any religion.
- Right to justice
- Right to live and travel anywhere in the country.
- Right to choose our profession
- Right to free and compulsory education for all children up to the age of 14.



#### Our Duties- Duties come along with our rights

Some of our important duties as citizens of India are given here.

- We must follow the rules laid down by the Constitution.
- We must honour the national flag and national anthem.
- We must defend our country at the time of danger.
- We must protect our national property.
- We must protect our environment.
- We must treat all Indians as equal.
