SECULAR

- This means that all people in the country would be free to follow whatever religion they want. This is known as the principle of secularism.



REPUBLIC

- This means that our head of state is elected by the people.
- India is headed by an elected president, unlike Britain whose head of state is a hereditary monarch.

You have the right to a good education.

You have the responsibility to do your best.

Our Fundamental Rights

- The Constitution of India gives its citizens certain fundamental rights.
- If anyone feels that his or her fundamental rights have been denied, he or she can approach a court of law.



Some of the important fundamental rights are given here:

- ❖ Right to equality
- ❖ Right to freedom of speech-we can speak freely without fear.
- ❖ Right to follow any religion.
- ❖ Right to justice
- ❖ Right to live and travel anywhere in the country.
- ❖ Right to choose our profession
- ❖ Right to free and compulsory education for all children up to the age of 14.



Our Duties- Duties come along with our rights

Some of our important duties as citizens of India are given here.

- ❖ We must follow the rules laid down by the Constitution.
- ❖ We must honour the national flag and national anthem.
- ❖ We must defend our country at the time of danger.
- ❖ We must protect our national property.
- ❖ We must protect our environment.
- ❖ We must treat all Indians as equal.
