**Q1. What is the difference between a mountain and a plateau?**

**Ans. Mountains are the rocky masses of land that rise higher than the surroundings.ex- Himalayas**

**Plateau- A large areas of land that is higher than the surroundings and more or less flat at the top is known as plateau.**

**Ex- Deccan plateau**

## **Q2. Define tributaries and distributaries.**

**And. Tributaries- Along the course of a river, several smaller rivers join the main rivers are called tributaries.**

**Ex- Gandak, Yamuna**

**Distributaries- Before entering into the sea, the river become very slow and carries a lot of sediments and keeps depositing on the way which causes the river to break up into channels called distributaries.**

**Ex- Padma, Hooghly**
