# Reflexive and Emphatic Pronouns

### At a glance

#### **REFLEXIVE PRONOUN**

Reflexive pronouns are pronouns that we use when the subject and object in a sentence refer to the same person. Such sentences do not make complete sense without reflexive pronouns.

For ex: The young boy dreams of buying a plane for himself.

Myself, yourself, himself, herself, itself, ourselves, yourselves and themselves are reflexive pronouns.

## **EMPHATIC PRONOUN**

When reflexive pronouns are used to put emphasis on a particular noun, they are called Emphatic pronoun. The sentence makes complete sense even when the emphatic pronoun is removed.

He himself made the beautiful painting.

They themselves made the cookies.
