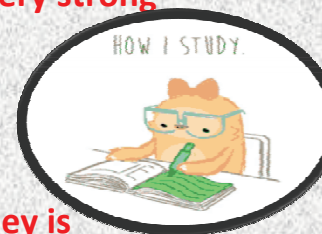
3) What do you understand by these lines?
