What is reflexive pronoun?

A reflexive pronoun comes when the subject and object refer to the same person or thing. Example: I don't need your help while I can do it myself. I cut myself when I was shaving. She blames herself for that incident.



What is an emphatic pronoun?

An emphatic <u>pronoun</u> refers back to another <u>noun</u> (or pronoun) in the <u>sentence</u> to emphasize it. For example:The Queen herself attended the party.

(*The Queen* is the noun being emphasized. It is called the <u>antecedent</u> of the emphatic pronoun.)

When used for emphasis, a word like *herself* is called an emphatic pronoun.



Personal pronouns (singular in number)

For example:-

- 1. I cook *myself*.
- 2.He cook *himself*.
- 3.You will cook *Yourself*.
- 4.She cook *herself*.
- 5.The dog ate *itself*.
- 6.She will go **herself**.
- 7.He will go **himself**.
- 8.You will hurt **yourself**.





Personal pronouns (plural in number)

For example:-We cook *ourselves*. we will go *ourselves*. You cook *yourselves*. you will go *yourselves*. They cook *themselves*. They will go *themselves*. You will hurt *yourselves*.



EMPHATIC PRONOUNS:- When Reflexive Pronouns are used to put emphasis , such pronouns are called Emphatic Pronouns.

For example:-

They will do it *themselves*. We will see to it *ourselves*. We will *ourselves* solve this problem. She cut her figure *herself*. He *himself* heard the remark. The town *itself* has very big market. You *yourself* can best explain. He cook *himself* at present.
