# What is a phrase?

# • Definition:

A phrase is a small group of words that adds meaning to a word.

A phrase is not a sentence because it is not a complete idea with a subject and a predicate.

#### WHAT ARE CLAUSES

# clause

a group of related words containing a subject that tells readers what the sentence is about and a verb that tells readers what the subject is doing

# **CLAUSES V. PHRASES**

#### **CLAUSES**

Must contain BOTH a subject and a predicate.

#### **Examples:**

When she forgot her car keys...

...things took a turn for the worse.

#### **PHRASES**

Do NOT require a subject or a predicate.

#### **Examples:**

Without her parents' blessing...

After the earthquake...

### Few examples and usage of clause

#### Clause

a group of words that functions as one part of speech and that includes a subject and a verb

1 a clause functioning as an adjective

My friend who has autism is brilliant at quizzes.

subject verb

Proof it's an adjective: My autistic friend is brilliant at quizzes.

2 a clause functioning as an adverb

He put on weight when he stopped running.

subject verb

Proof it's an adverb: He put on weight quickly.

a clause functioning as a noun

I cannot remember what happened last night.

subject verb

Proof it's a noun: I cannot remember a thing.
