Independent

A group of words that contains a subject and a verb.

Makes sense on its own as a sentence.

For example:

- Jane ate pasta.
- Sam went to the park.



A group of words that contains a subject and a verb.

Doesn't make sense on its own as a sentence.

For example:

- because she was hungry.
 - after he finished school.



Examples of Dependent Clauses

- When she fell out of the apple tree.
- As he approached the top of the ridge.
- Where Alex sat crying in the mud.
- Because his pants wouldn't fit him anymore.
- After you finish sorting your sock collection.
- If you're very sweet to me.
- Before he started chewing on his tie.
 - ™Typically, dependent clauses begin with a word that keeps the clause from being independent.




