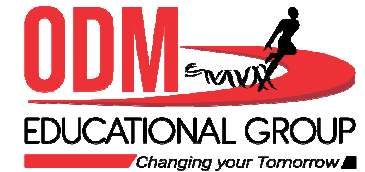

# What is a phrase?



A group of words related to the subject or predicate.

**Hiding under the table,** the dog knew he was bad.

Mickey Mouse, **the world's best animal character,** enraged the student.

# Clause-Definition

A clause is a group of words that contains a verb and its subject

Examples:

The stallion tossed his mane happily.

The barbed-wire fence guards the house.

After the last sailboat crossed the finish line



Independent Clause	Dependent Clause
Asif plays hockey	<u>as</u> he enjoys it.
Shazia could not catch the bus	<u>because</u> she was late.
Ali could not finish the the mathematics test	<u>although</u> he knew all the sums.
Arifa quickly ate her lunch	<u>as</u> she was very hungry.
Harris is back from work	<u>so</u> he must take rest.
You must work hard	<u>if</u> you want to succeed in life.

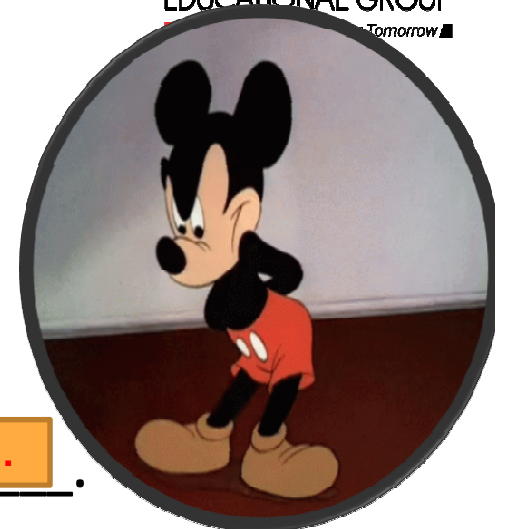
c) She was shouting very loudly as I could not hear her.

❖ **Picture C** – Do not communicate over phone while driving because it can be dangerous.

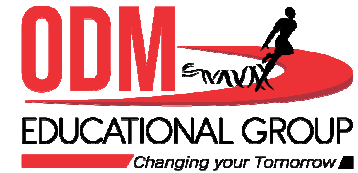
❖ **Picture D** – As the water is running, there is chance of water scarcity.

❖ **Picture E** – Brush your teeth twice daily otherwise it will cause cavity.

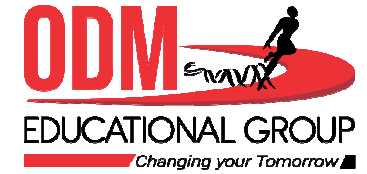
❖ **Picture F** - Always close the tap so that there is no loss of water
