#### **Conditionals**

**O Conditional**Used for **present**real/factual situations

**1st Conditional**Used for **future**Real/factual situations

2nd Conditional
Used for present or
future unreal situations

**3st Conditional**Used for **past** unreal situations

#### If clause

Present simple If it rains,

#### **1st Conditional**

If I have enough Money,

#### **2nd Conditional**

If I had Money,

#### **3st Conditional**

If he had talked to me,

#### Main clause

Present simple the ground gets wet.

#### **1st Conditional**

I will buy a car.

#### 2nd Conditional

I **would** give you.

(but I don't have money)

#### 3st Conditional

I would have listened to him.

(but he didn't talk to me)
