LEARNING OBJECTIVE

Enable the students to

- 1) Gather knowledge about prefix and suffix.
- 2) Form prefix and suffix.
- 3) Make use of prefix and suffix in sentences.

What is prefix?

A **prefix** is an affix which is placed before the stem of a word. Adding it to the beginning of one word changes it into another word. For **example**, when the **prefix** un- is added to the word happy, it creates the word unhappy.

Several prefixes serve to make the new word mean the opposite, or nearly the opposite, of the original meaning of the base word. Examples: Activate - deactivate

What is suffix?

A **suffix** is a letter or group of letters, for **example** '-ly' or '-ness', which is added to the end of a word in order to form a different word, often of a different word class. For **example**, the **suffix** '-ly' is added to 'quick' to form 'quickly'.
