

#### **CONJUNCTIONS**

Words that are used for joining other words, phrases or sentences are called conjunctions.

and	because	while
but	before	yet

Life is full of troubles **yet** none wants to die.



Robin did not try hard **so** he did not succeed.

Play up to your potential otherwise, you will be left out of the team.

A conjunction which makes a connection between two parallel words, two parallel phrases, or independent clauses is called a coordinating conjunction. The coordinating conjunctions are *and*, *but*, *or*, *as well as*, *for*, *so*, *yet*, etc.

The conjunctions that connect groups of words or <u>phrases</u> which are generally similar in <u>nature</u> are called as <u>Coordinating Conjunctions</u>.
