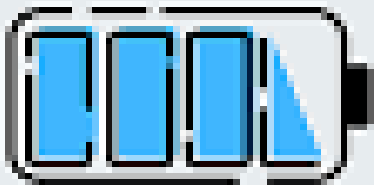

Ans) The literary device is a technique a writer uses to produce a special effect in his/her writing.

What is personification?

Ans) Personification is a literary device in which human characteristics or attributes are given to animals, birds or objects. These characteristics could be human emotions, gestures, thoughts or actions.

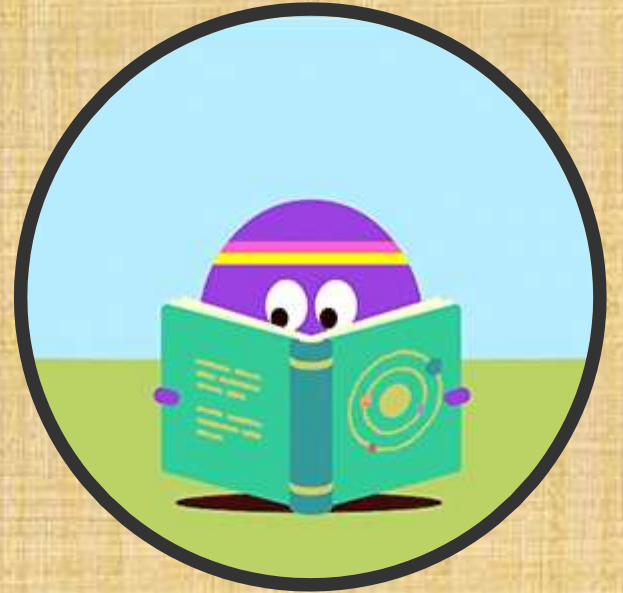
