Adjectives

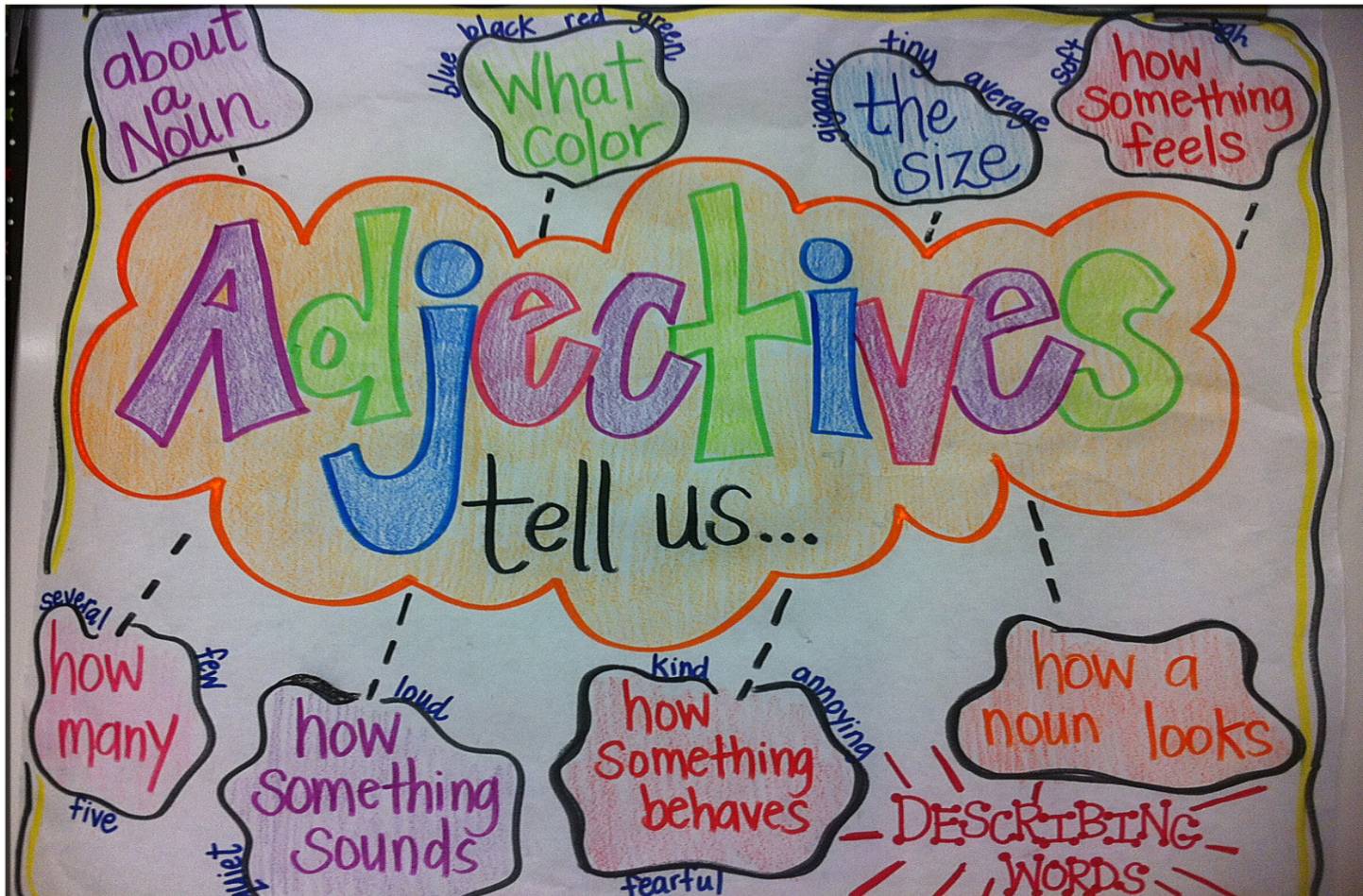


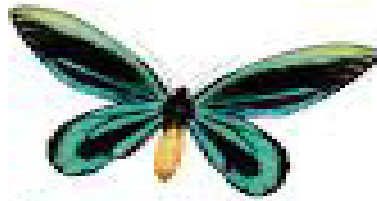
Adjectives are describing words.

flew away.



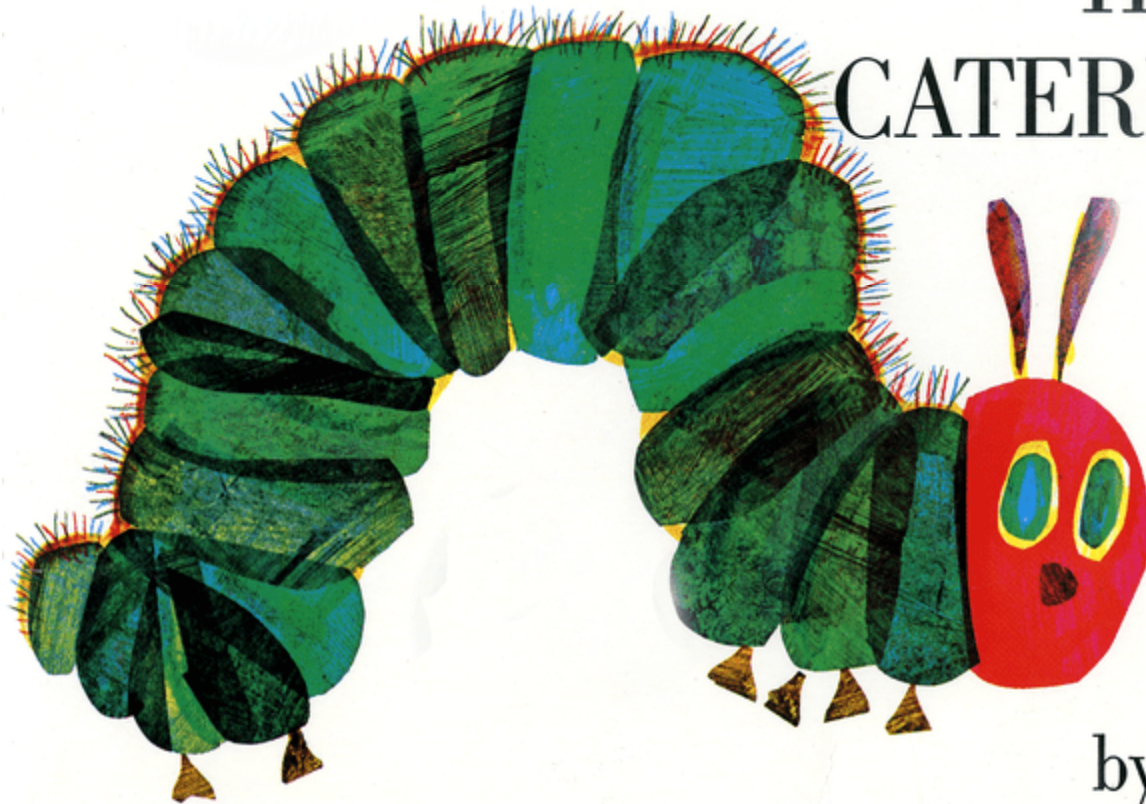
An amethyst is a

Adjective of Quality

- An adjective that tells us about the **kind of a person, a place or thing** we are referring to is called an adjective of quality.


Examples



Mukesh Ambani is a ***wealthy*** man.

I read an ***interesting*** book

2. Adjectives of Quantity

 **Adjectives of Quantity** show *how much* of a thing is meant.

Examples:-

1. I ate *some* rice.
2. He has *little* intelligence.
3. He showed *much* patience.
4. He has lost *all* his wealth.

Adjectives of Quantity answer the question: *How much?*

Adjectives of Quantity

3. Adjectives of Number (Numeral Adjective)

- **Adjectives of Number (Numeral Adjective)** show how many persons or things are meant, or in what order a person or thing stands.

Example:-

1. The hand has *five* fingers.
2. *Most* boys like cricket.
3. Sunday is the *first* day of the week.
4. There are *no* pictures in this book.
5. Here are *some* ripe mangoes.

Adjectives of Number answer the question: *How many?*

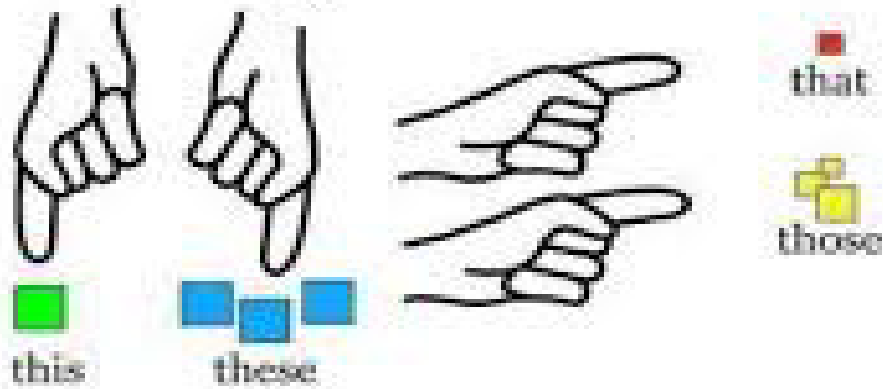

Demonstrative Adjectives



Interrogative Adjectives

Interrogative adjectives are words, such as **which**, **whose** and **what** that are used along with nouns to ask questions .

Examples:-

- Which plants should be watered twice a week?
- What book are you reading?



DISTRIBUTIVE ADJECTIVES :
an adjective that points out
each person or thing separately
is called Distributive Adjective.

e.g.-each, every, either,
neither, etc.
