What is phonics?

It is the sound of spoken English with individual letters or group of letters. It is a method of learning how to read and pronounce words.

**For ex: ch – chain, cheese, church
wh – wheel, whisper, whale**

Silent letter

A silent letter is a letter that in a particular word, does not correspond to any sound.

For ex – b in subtle, t in listen, g in design etc
