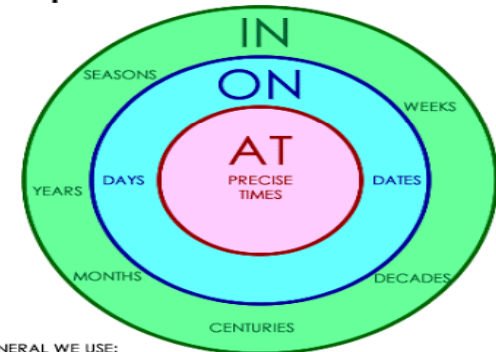
What is a Preposition?

A Preposition is a word which is placed before a noun or a pronoun to show the relation in which the person or thing denoted by the Noun to something else.

Preposition of Time

It tells us about the time of an action.

Prepositions of Time



IN GENERAL WE USE:

AT for precise times.

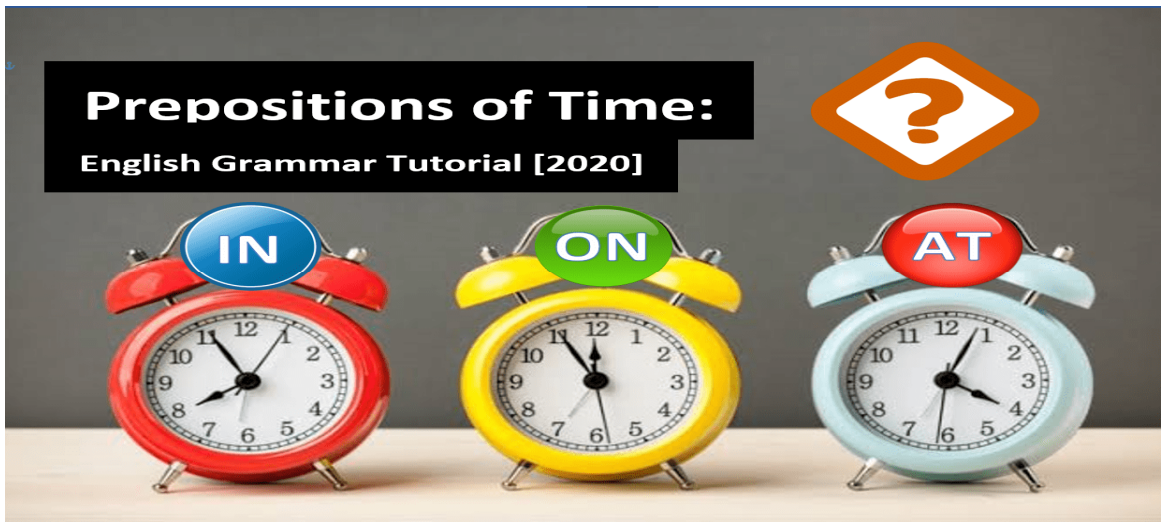
ON for days and dates.

IN for Centuries, years, months, season and long periods of time.

COMMON EXCEPTIONS:

IN the morning; **IN** the afternoon; **IN** the evening; **AT** night

ON Christmas Day but **AT** Christmas; **AT** the moment; **AT** sunset



Preposition of Place

It tells us about the location of a noun or pronoun.

Preposition of Movement/Direction

It tells us about the movement or direction of a noun or pronoun.
