e. Constellations

Ans- Some of the stars appear to form beautiful pattern in the sky, such a group of stars is called a constellation.

Ex- Scorpius, Orion, Leo etc.

f. Rotation

Ans- The earth moves around the sun as well as on its axis. This movement is called rotation. The earth completes one rotation in about 24 hours.
