3. Answer the following questions.

a. Explain about constellations.

Ans- A group of stars form patterns in the sky. One group of stars appears in the shape of a hunter, another as the outline of a lion. These group of stars are called constellations. Ex- Scorpius, Orion, Leo etc.

b. Explain what is water cycle?

Ans- When the sun shines, water from the rivers, ponds, lakes and oceans heats up and rises in the form of water vapour. This water vapour comes in contact with cold air. It cools down to form tiny drops of water to form clouds. On cooling further, these tiny drops become heavy and fall as rain. The rainwater flows back to the rivers, ponds, lakes and ocean. This cycle of change of water is called the water cycle.

c. Write the names of Indian Astronomers.

Ans- The names of three astronomers are Aryabhata, Varahamihira and Aryabhata.
