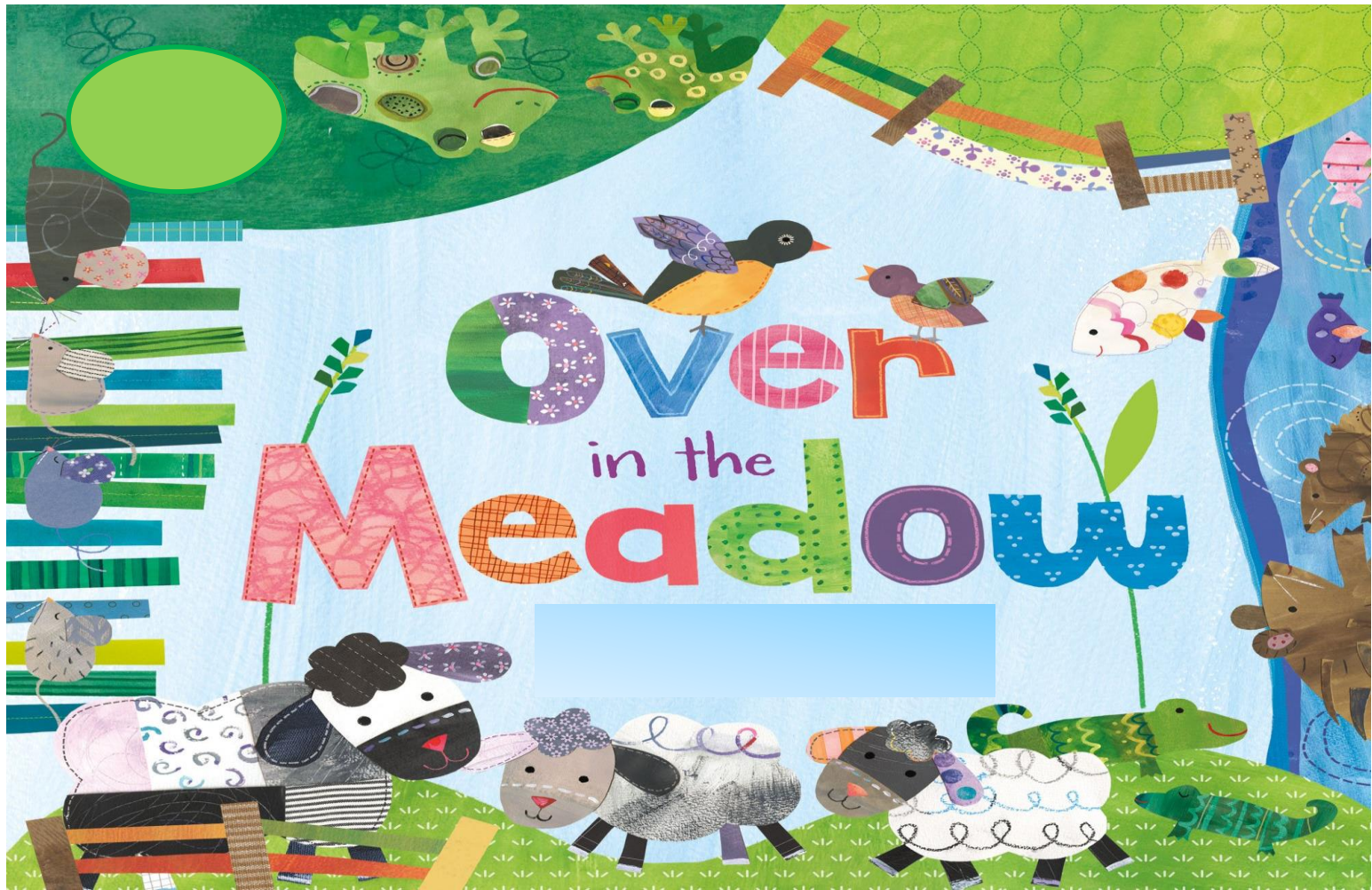

OVER IN THE MEADOW

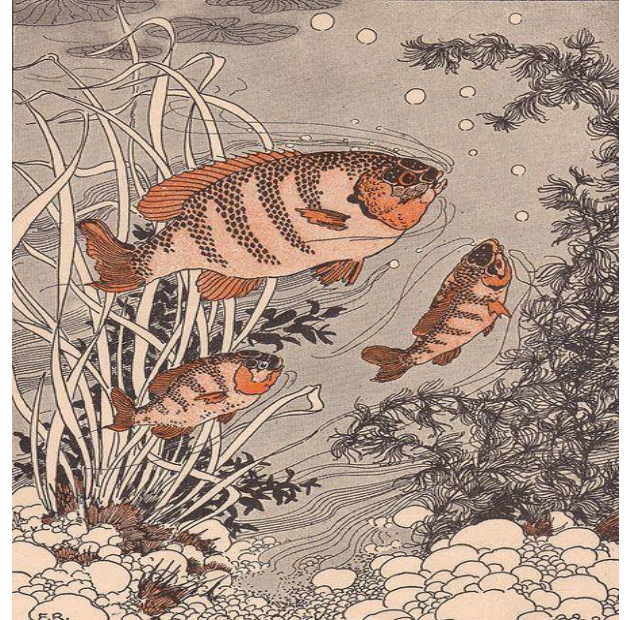
A meadow is a grassy place near a river. Many animals live in and around meadows. Let us read a poem about a meadow and the animals who live there.
