Future Tenses: Simple & Continuous





- I <u>will buy a toy train tomorrow.</u>
- They will go to Delhi next Sunday.

The above sentences speak about an action that will happen in the future. They are in future tense. We will learn about Simple Future tense and Future Continuous tense.

Simple Future Tense

- It is used to denote facts or events of certainty.
- It is used to give a warning or take a spontaneous decision.
- To express readiness.
- Make an offer or suggestion.
- To give an invitation or an order to someone.



Some examples :

- I will prepare dinner.
- Why will not / won't you tell her the truth?
- It will rain tomorrow.

Structure of Simple Future Tense

Subject + will / shall + main verb

it has another structure as well.

Subject + am / is / are + going to + main verb

This structure is used for informal way of writing or speech. Rechel is going to dance in the annual day celebration.

To change it into negative we add not.

- Structure
- Subject + will /shall + not + main verb

Rashmi will not write the letter to his brother.

- I shall not go to the picnic.
- Subject + is/am/are+ not + going to + verb
- He is not going to complete his work .
- I am not going to give up until I achieve my goal.
