Future Tenses: Continuous



Future continuous tense:

It is also known as future progressive tense, is a verb tense that indicates that something will occur in the future and continue for an expected length of time.

They will be cooking food at this time.

I will be going to the school at 8am tomorrow.

It is formed using the construction

Will + be + the present participle(the root verb+ ing)

I will be helping Alex tomorrow.

When you arrive, I will be sitting in the park.
