# **ACTIVITY:**

### **Materials required:**

- Papers (black/ white /green/brown A4 size sheet)
- Glue
- Scissors
- Pencil or Sketch pen for drawing
- Colour pencil for colouring





## **PROCEDURE**

- Take a white sheet cut it into the shape similar to oval.
- Now take black sheet and make cut out of legs and hands of panda.
- Again with the help of black sheet make the cut outs of two eyes, ears and one nose.
- Cut two small circles for white portion of eyes and colour it to look like eyes of panda.
- For making narrow stick of bamboo, take brown sheet and make cut out accordingly.
- Leaves should be made with the help of green sheet( if available).
- Assemble all the cut outs and paste in their appropriate places.
