RECAPITULATION

Animals reproduce in two different ways

By laying eggs

Giving birth to young ones

Shedding of old skin or shell.

Moulting

Largest aquatic mammal.

ACTIVITY:

Material required:

- Paper (green/ any colour, 4 any size)
- Glue
- Scissors
- Pencil or Sketch pen for drawing
- Colour pencil for colouring
- White beads (optional)





PROCEDURE

- Take a paper and cut it into round shape.
- Take another paper (green) and draw four leaves,
 cut it into the shape of leaves.
- Paste some white beads or small paper balls to show eggs on the leaf.
- Cut a paper into long narrow shape and wrap it around the pencil to form a caterpillar's body.
- For making pupa (chrysalis) stick a tube shaped green paper on the leaf.
- Take small square of paper and fold it into a zig-zag form to get the wings of butterfly.
- Make the body of butterfly on the paper and cut it out.
- You can also make the head of caterpillar for more creativity.
- Label the different stages of lifecycle of a butterfly.
