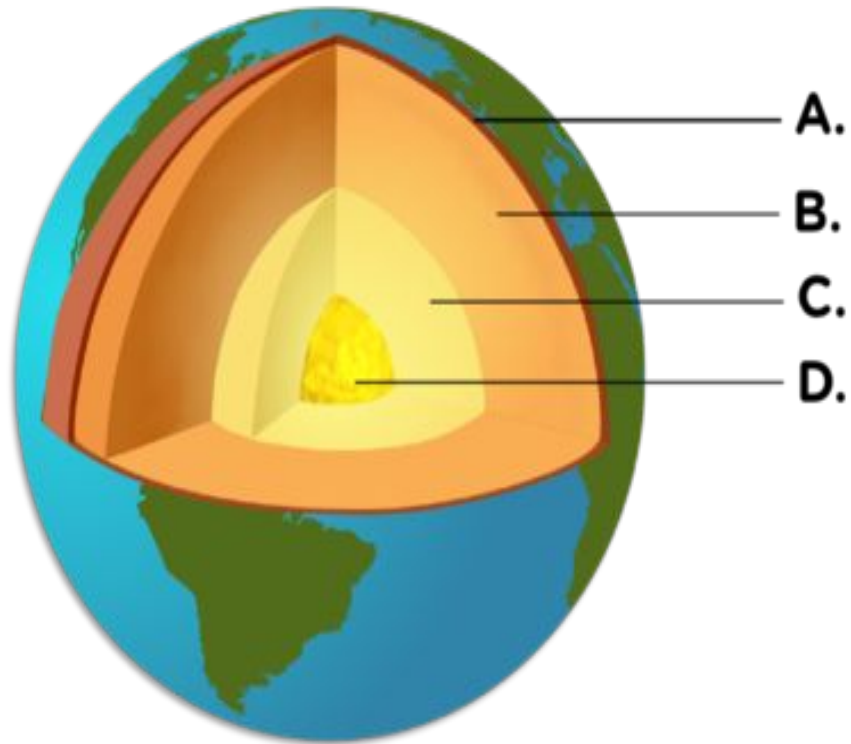

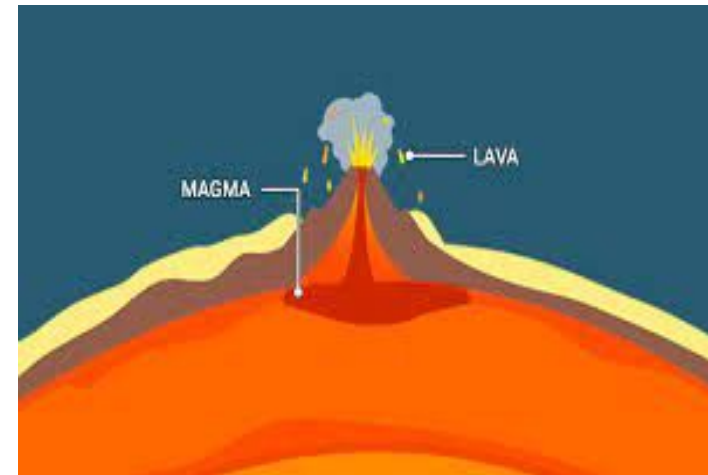

VOLCANO

- A volcano is a mountain that erupts.
- Rock under the earth's surface is so hot that it melts.
- This melted rock is called magma.
- Erupting magma is called lava.



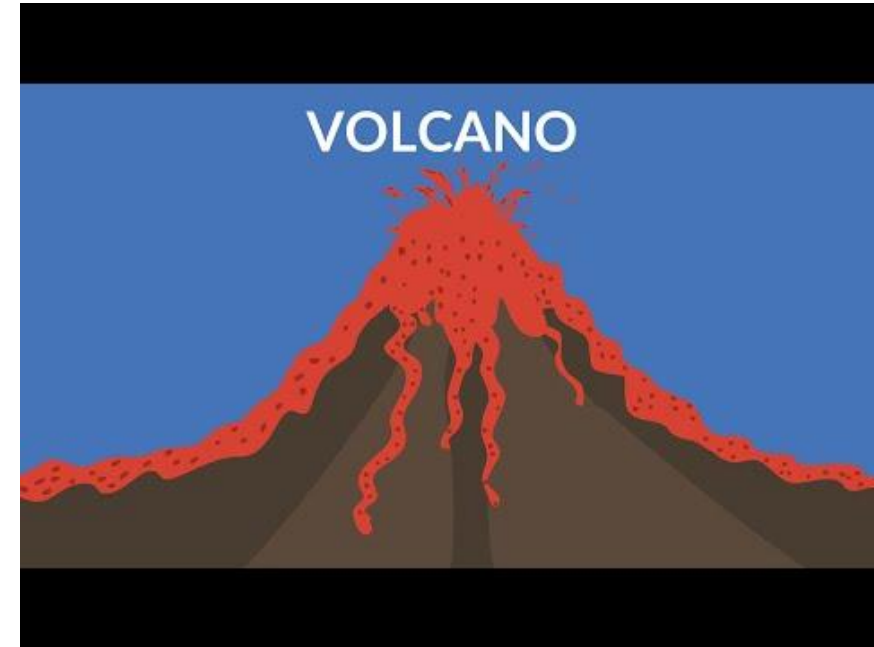
FORMATION OF VOLCANO

- A volcano is an opening in the earth's crust through which lava, volcanic ash, and gases escape.
- Beneath a volcano, liquid magma containing dissolved gases rises through cracks in the Earth's crust.



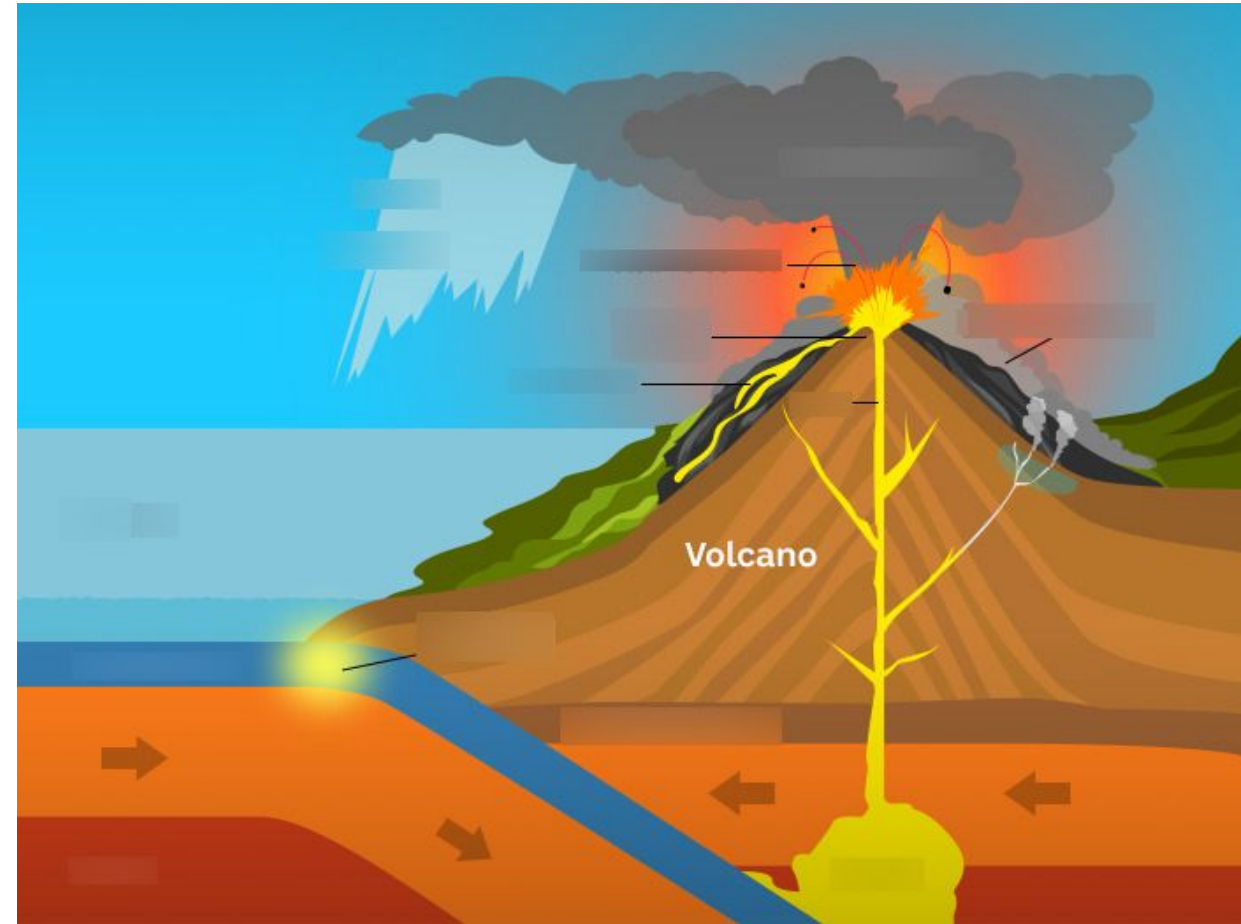
FORMATION OF VOLCANO

- Volcanoes on Earth form from rising magma.
- Magma can rise when pieces of Earth's crust called tectonic plates slowly move away from each other.
- The magma rises up to fill in the space.
- As the magma rises, bubbles of gas form inside it.
- Runny magma erupts through openings or vents in the earth's crust before flowing onto its surface as lava.
- If magma is thick, gas bubbles cannot easily escape and pressure builds up as the magma rises.



CAUSES OF VOLCANO

- A build up of pressure in the earth is released, by things such as a plate movement which forces molten rock to exploded into the air causing a volcanic eruption.



STATUSES OF VOLCANO

- An active volcano is one which has recently erupted and there is a possibility that it may erupt soon.
- A dormant volcano is one which has not erupted in a long time but there is a possibility it can erupt in the future.
- A volcano which has not erupted in the past 10,000 years is often listed as extinct.



EFFECTS OF VOLCANOES

- **Volcanoes can change the weather. They can cause rain, thunder and lightning.**
- **Volcanoes can also have long-term effects on the climate, making the world cooler.**
- **Fast-moving lava can kill people and falling ash can make it hard for them to breathe.**
