# The fox and the crow

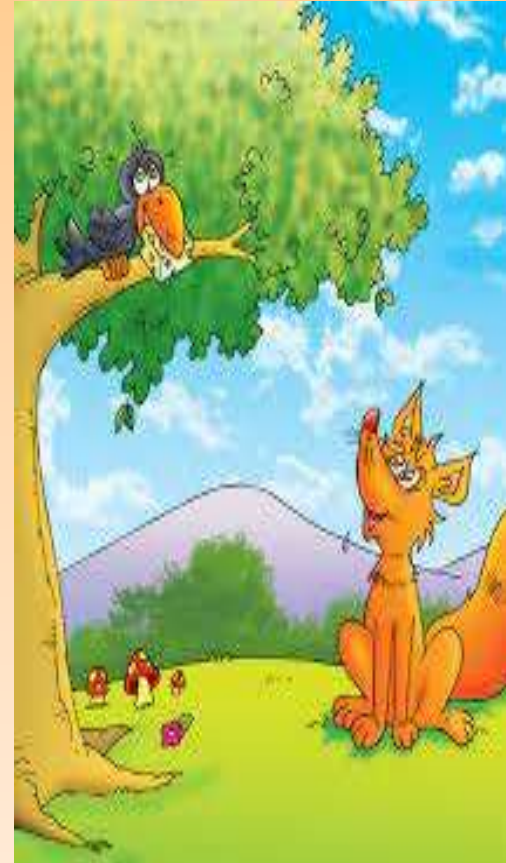
Mr Crow was perched upon a lamb,
