Deserts:-

Deserts are large extremely dry areas of land.

There is very little rainfall and few plants grow in deserts.

Desert soil having very extreme temperature.

In summer the days are very hot and nights are cool in winter days are cool and nights are very very cold.



Plateaus:

Area of land that is higher than the surrounding and more or less flat at the top is called plateau.

Examples:

- ❖ The Deccan Plateau in the South India covers the Indian peninsula.
- ❖ The Tibetan plateau the Himalaya is the highest plateau in the world .
It is also known as the roof of the world.
- ❖ The Columbia and Colorado plateaus are in the USA.

A landmass which projects into the sea and is surrounded by water on three sides is called Peninsula.

The tip of the peninsula is called Cape.



Example:- The Southern part of India is Peninsula.and the Southern tip of Indian Peninsula is called Cape Comorin.

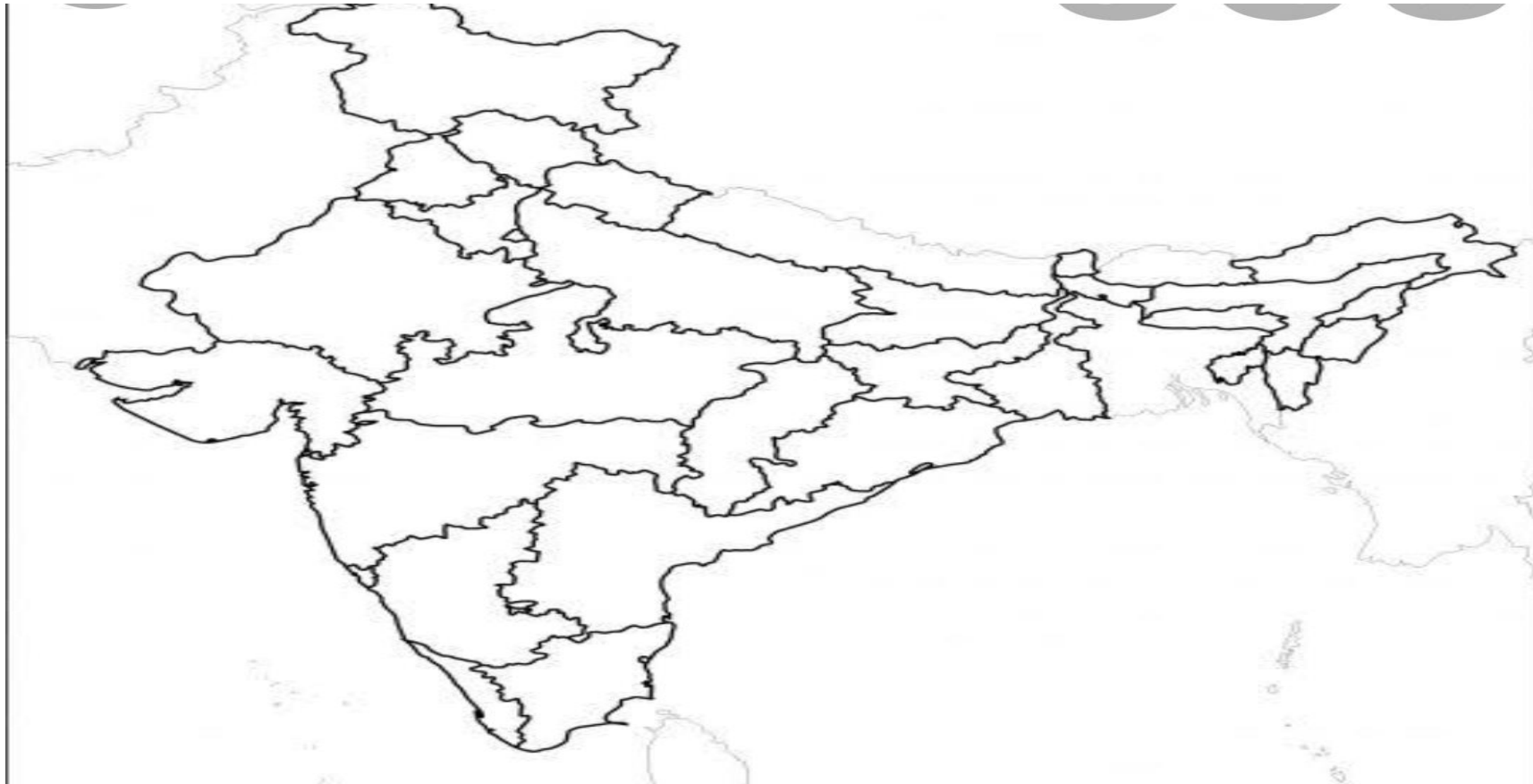
The Arabian Peninsula is the largest peninsula in the world.

Ex- The Bay of Bengal along with the Eastern Coast of India.



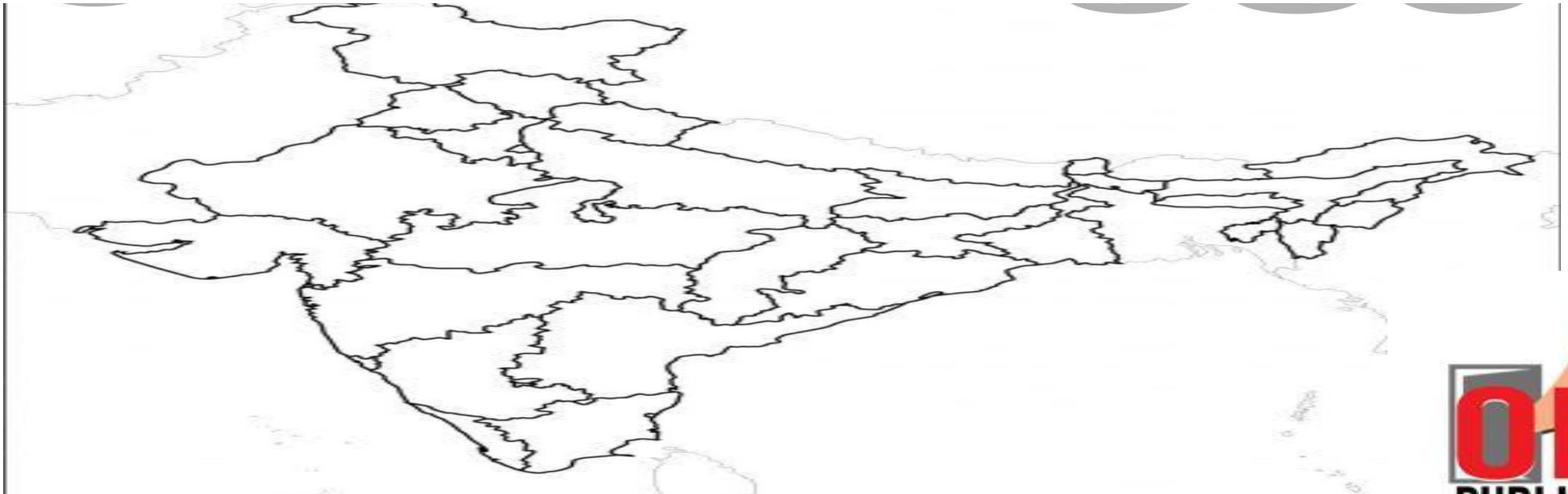
An Island is a land mass surrounded on by all sides water.
