





## Four peculiarity of literacy in India:

- (i) The literacy rates have increased from 18% in 1951 to 74%in 2011.
- (ii) A vast difference is noticed across different sections of the population. Literacy among males is nearly 16.6% higher than females and it is about 16.6% higher in urban areas as compared to the rural areas.
- (iii) Literacy rates vary from 96% in some districts of Kerala to below 62% in some parts of Madhya Pradesh and Bihar.
- (iv) According to the census of 2001, a person aged 7 years and above who can read and write with understanding in any language is treated as literate.
