- it is marked with great regional differences.






- 3. poverty has declined more in China and south- East Asian countries.
- 4. World Bank Has Defined Poverty As the people earning Less Than 1.90\$ per day.




- Poverty declined substantially in China and Southeast Asian countries-ECONOMIC GROWTH AND MASSIVE INVESTMENT IN HUMAN RESOURCE.
- 2. It has come down 85% in 1981 to 6% in 2011 to 1.7% in 2019.
- 3. In the countries of South Asia(India,Pakistan,Sri Lanka,Nepal,Bangladesh And Bhutan) the decline has not been as rapid.



- In Sub-Saharan Africa,
  poverty in fact declined from
  51% in 1981 to 47%in 2008.
- In Latin America, the ratio of Poverty remained the same.
- 3. poverty also resurfaced in some of the former socialist countries like russia, where officially it was non-existence earlier.


