1. There has been substantial decline in global poverty.

2. it is marked with great regional differences.

3. poverty has declined more in China and south- East Asian countries.

4. World Bank Has Defined Poverty As the people earning Less Than 1.90\$ per day.

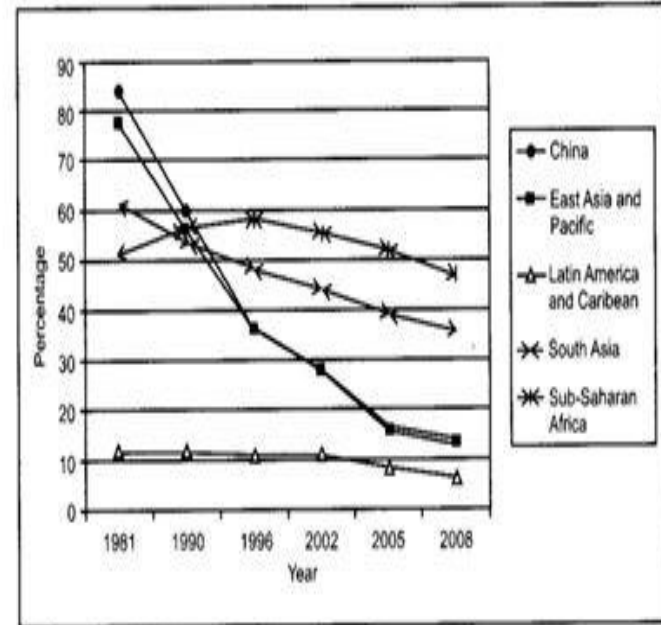


1. Poverty declined substantially in China and Southeast Asian countries-ECONOMIC GROWTH AND MASSIVE INVESTMENT IN HUMAN RESOURCE.
2. It has come down 85% in 1981 to 6% in 2011 to 1.7% in 2019.
3. In the countries of South Asia(India,Pakistan,Sri Lanka,Nepal,Bangladesh And Bhutan) the decline has not been as rapid.



1. In Sub-Saharan Africa, poverty in fact declined from 51% in 1981 to 47% in 2008.
2. In Latin America, the ratio of Poverty remained the same.
3. poverty also resurfaced in some of the former socialist countries like Russia, where officially it was non-existence earlier.

Graph : Share of people living on \$1.25 a day

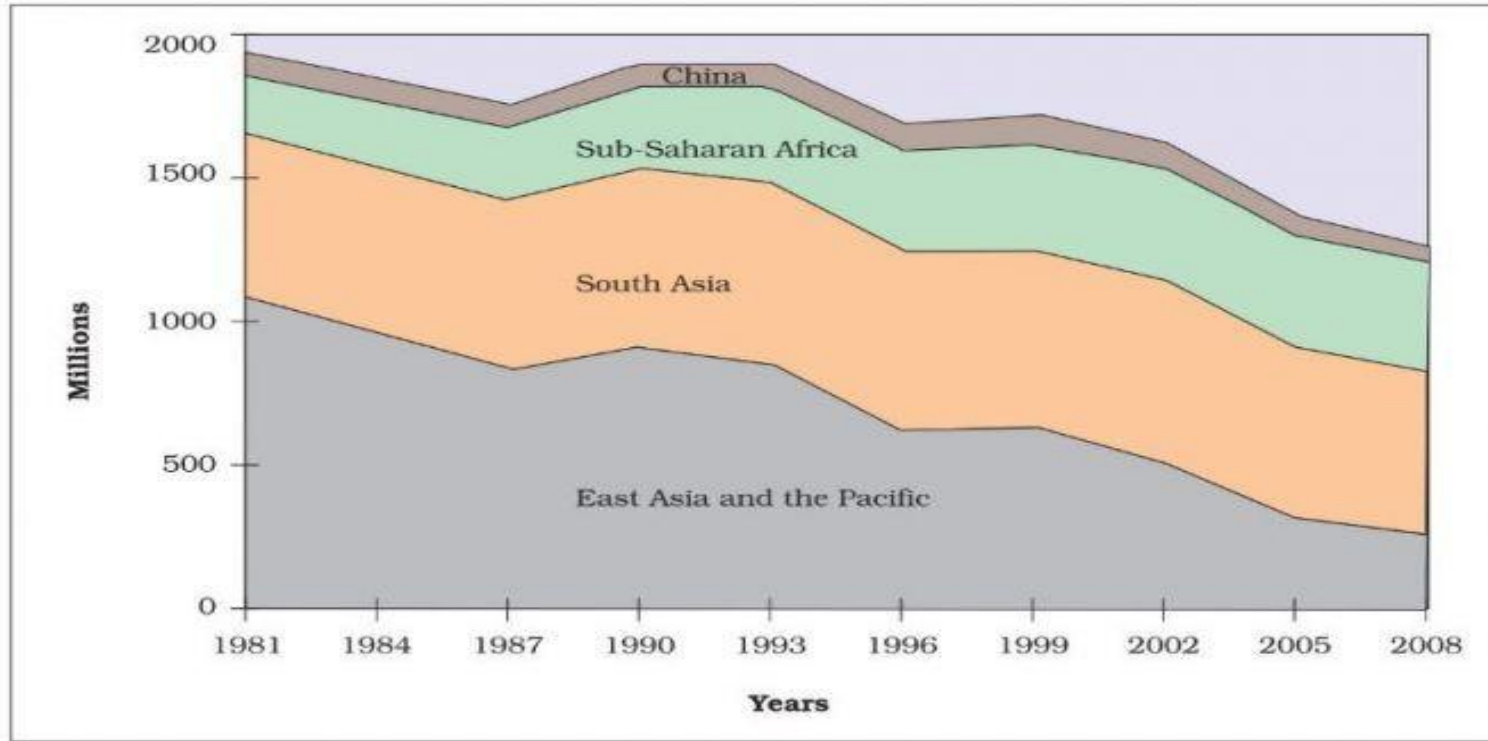
