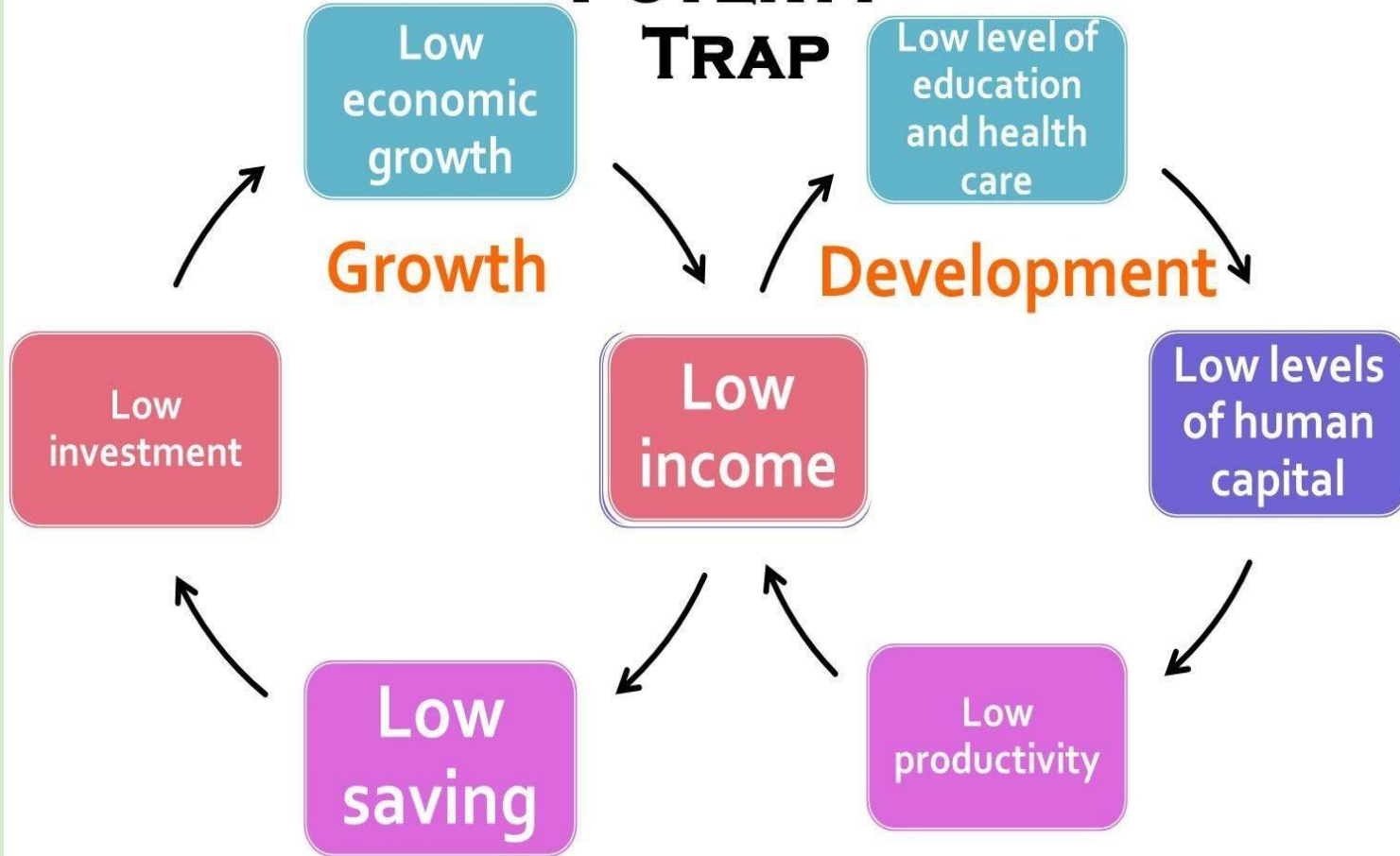

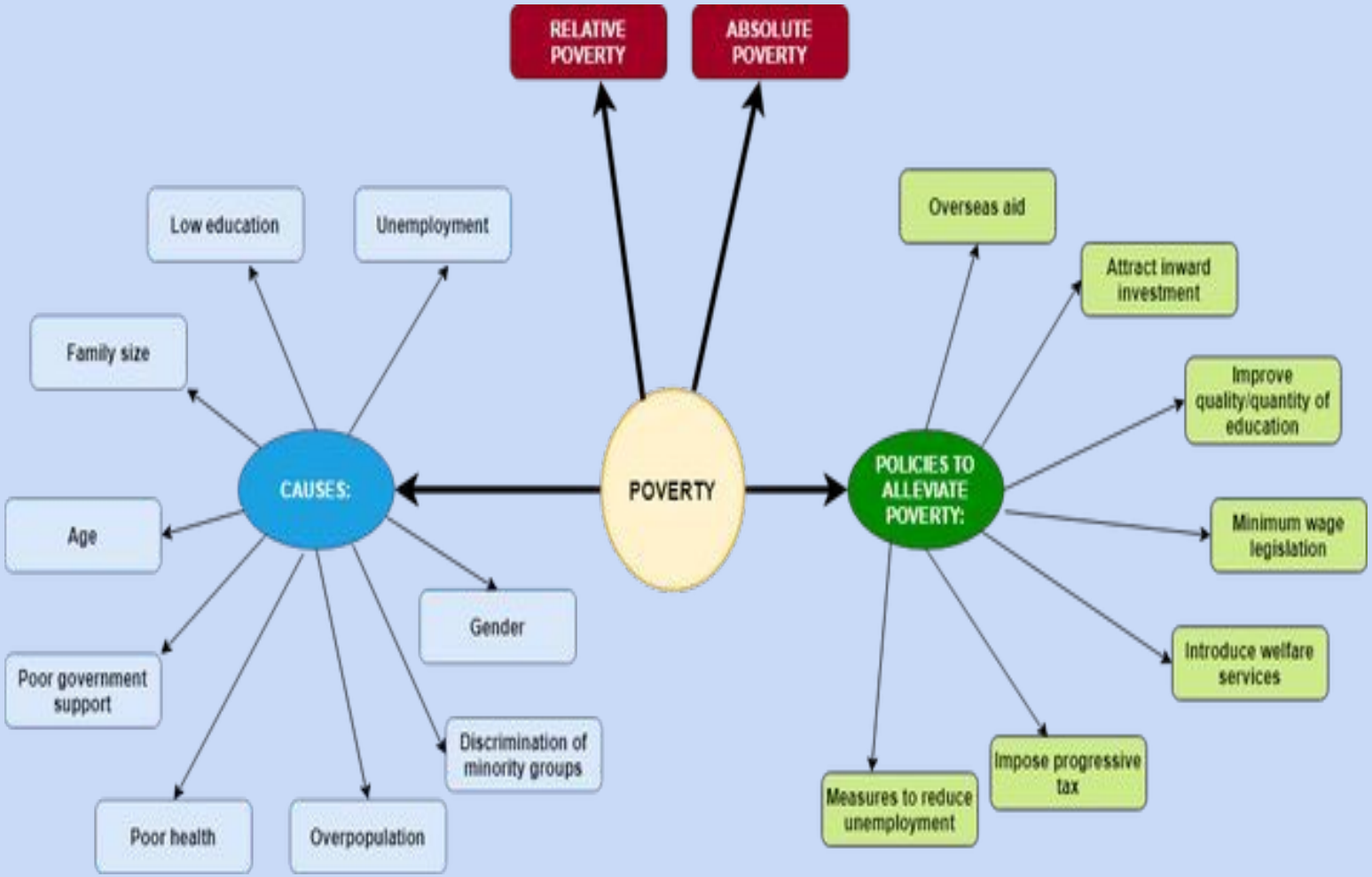

POVERTY TRAP



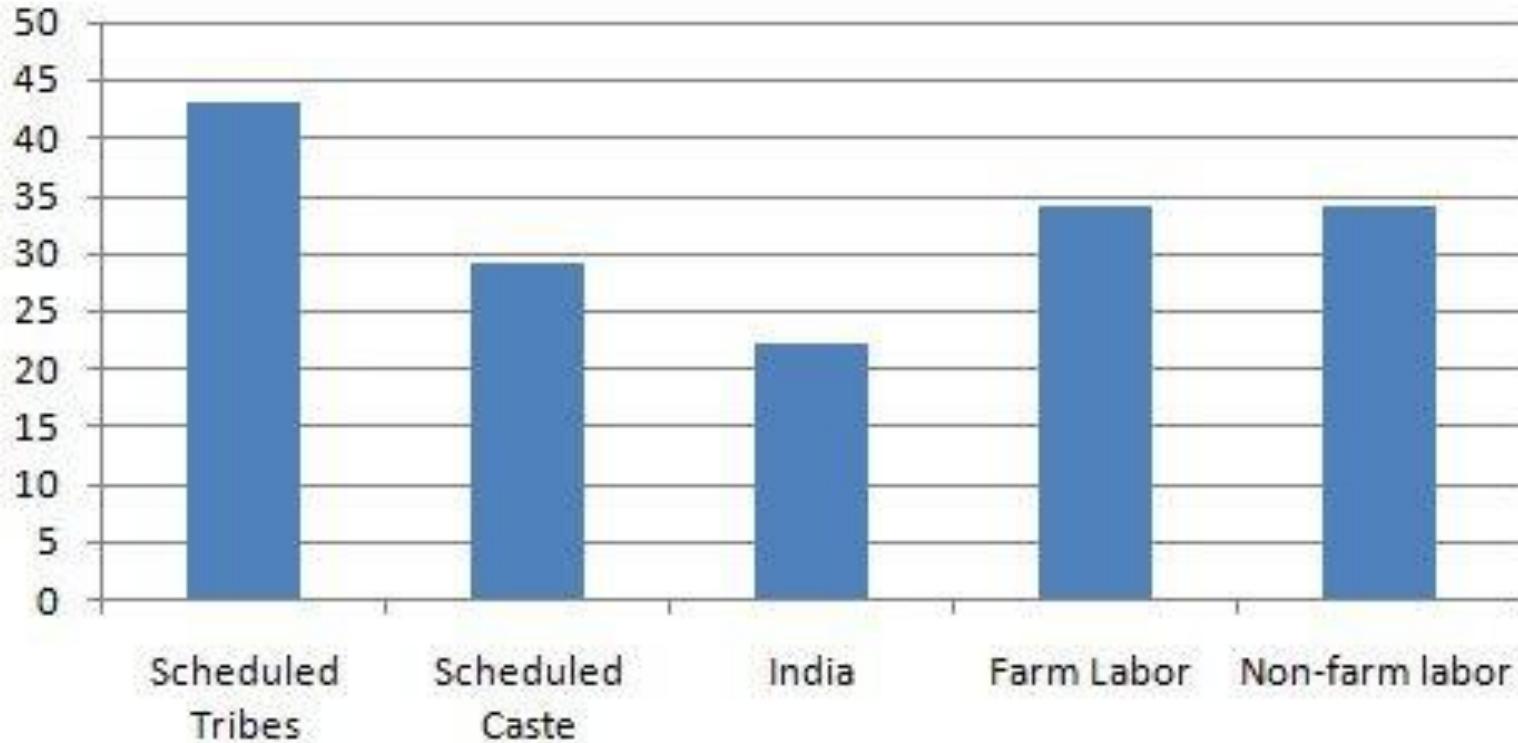


INTERSTATE DISPARITY IN POVERTY
