

# SPREAD OF COMMUNICABLE DISEASES THROUGH THE AIR

- Germs that cause diseases like chickenpox, whooping cough, diphtheria, influenza and scarlet fever are present in the discharge from the nose and the mouth of a patient.
- These diseases can spread through sneezing and coughing, when germs are passed from one person to another through the air.



# SPREAD OF COMMUNICABLE DISEASES THROUGH INSECTS

- Diseases like malaria, yellow fever, plague, dengue and kala-azar are caused by blood sucking insects like mosquitoes, fleas, bugs and Sand flies.



# SPREAD OF COMMUNICABLE DISEASES THROUGH INSECTS

- Plague is caused by the bites of rat fleas.
- Dengue fever is transmitted to a person by a bite of an Andes mosquitoes that is infected with dengue fever.
- Malaria is caused by a protozoan which is carried by the female Anopheles mosquitoes.

# **SPREAD OF COMMUNICABLE DISEASES THROUGH CARRIERS**

- Some diseases spread by healthy carriers of germs.
- A healthy person may carry germs of typhoid, cholera, dysentery, etc. in his body.
- Such a person usually does not suffer from the disease.
- However, people who came into contact with the carrier are in danger of catching the disease.

# **SPREAD OF COMMUNICABLE DISEASES THROUGH CARRIERS**

- AIDS is an incurable communicable disease that damages the immune system of the person and leads to death.
- It is spread by a virus called HIV.



# **SUMMARY**

- **Chickenpox, whooping cough, diphtheria, influenza and scarlet fever are spread through air.**
- **Mosquitoes, fleas, bugs and Sand flies are carriers of communicable diseases like malaria, yellow fever, plague, dengue and kala- azar.**
- **AIDS is an incurable communicable disease that damages the immune system of the person and leads to death.**
