WARM UP

PREVENTION OF COMMUNICABLE DISEASES

- Disinfect or boil the articles used by the diseased person to kill the germs.
- Spray disinfectants on the floor and the walls of the room to disinfect it.



PREVENTION OF COMMUNICABLE DISEASES

- Cases of infectious diseases must be reported to the civic authorities.
- Children with communicable disease should stay away from school.
- Progress in the field of medicine and immunization helped us to get rid of many diseases.
- Prevent the breeding of germs / mosquitoes.
