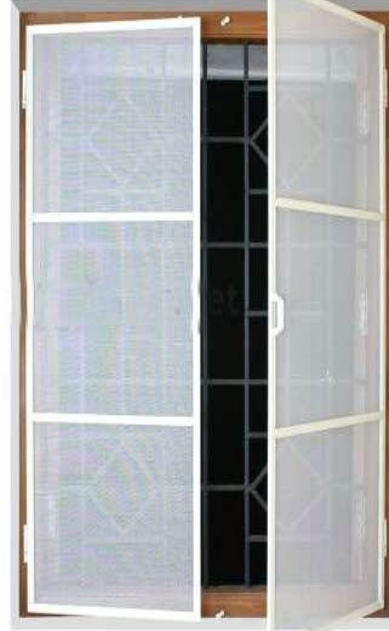
METHODS FOR PREVENTION

- Houses should be airy and open to let in sunlight and air.
- Mattresses, linen and clothes should be exposed to sunlight.
- A clean and germ-free water should be used.
- Water should be boiled to kill germs.



METHODS FOR PREVENTION

- Water filters should be used to purify water.
- Huge amount to water can be purified by chlorination.
- Stagnant water should be avoided.
- Rooms should have wire screens.



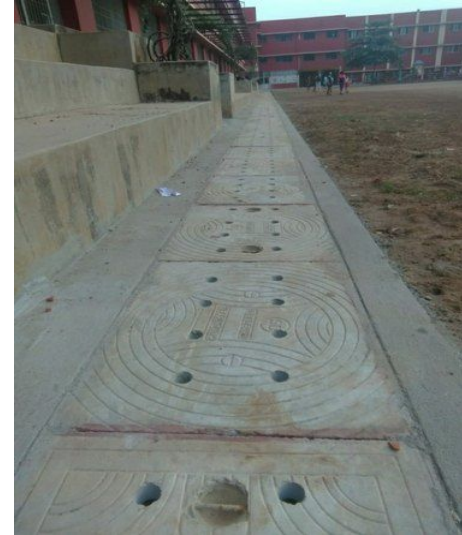
METHODS FOR PREVENTION

- Toilets and bathrooms should be cleaned and disinfected.
- Water in tanks and ponds should be sprayed with oil to prevent breeding of mosquitoes.



METHODS FOR PREVENTION

- Mosquito nets and repellents should be used.
- Drains must be covered.
