FOR CUTS AND SCRATCHES


- Wash away all dirt around the wound.
- Clean the affected area with cotton wool soaked in an antiseptic lotion.
- Place a thick pad of cotton wool or sterile gauze on the wound and press it with your thumb and fingers.
- A tourniquet can be used to stop bleeding.
- Wrap a sterile gauze bandage around the wounded area.
