A computer is made up of different parts. A computer .all these parts together make a computer work.

A computer is a machine that has four main parts.

- Monitor
- CPU
- Keyboard
- Mouse

Monitor:

- It looks like the screen of a television.
- It displays the results.
- It shows the text typed and the work done by us.

CPU:

- CPU stands for central processing unit.
- It is known as brain of computer.
- It helps the computer to think and do all its work
- Other parts are attached to the CPU by wires.
- It helps a computer to remember things.

Keyboard:

- A keyboard has many buttons known as keys.
- It is used to type letters, words, numbers and special symbols.
- A standard keyboard has 104 keys.





Mouse:

- Mouse has two buttons.
- It is used to point, move and select any item on the computer screen.
- It also helps us to draw pictures and play games.

Types of Mouse:

A mouse can be of different types:

Scroll Mouse:

- A scroll mouse has a scroll wheel in the middle of the left and right buttons.
- We can move page up and down by moving the scroll wheel.



Ball Mouse:

A ball mouse has a ball under it which helps to move the mouse pointer



Optical Mouse:

An optical mouse uses light instead of a ball for the movement of the mouse pointer.

Apart from the four main parts, some other parts of a computer that can be attached to it for different functions.

Printer:

- It is used to print the text or pictures on a paper.
- It can print both in black and white or colour.
- The printed copy on a paper is called Hard Copy.



Speaker:

It is used to listen to music and hear the sound effects stored in a computer.







Microphone and headphone:



- Microphone helps us to record our voice and different sounds into the computer.
- It helps us to talk to our friends through the internet.

Headphone:

A headphone helps users to listen to music as well as recorded sounds without disturbing others. .



Compact Disk (CD):

- CD is round in shape. It is used to store a lot of information.
- It is a shiny disk that runs on a CD drive.
- The CD drive is fixed in the CPU.

Hard Disk:

- Hard Disk is like a box, which is fixed inside the CPU.
- It is used to store computer data.

Pen Drive:

• It is small rectangular device, that is used for transferring data from one computer to another.
