


Read these lines



The sun was shining and the birds were singing as the elephant came out of the jungle. The other animals were relaxing in the shade of the trees, but the elephant moved very quickly. She was looking for her baby, and she didn't notice the hunter who was watching her through his binoculars. When the shot rang out, she was running towards the river.

The words in red are verbs that talk about the actions that began in past and went on for some time. These words are said to be in the **Past Continuous tense**.

The **Past Continuous tense** is used to talk about actions that began in the past and continued for some time.



Examples:



Raj was travelling by train.



We were playing basketball after school.

The Past Continuous tense is used to:

• show an action that continued for some time in the past

Examples:



Mrs. Sharma was teaching in the class.

The children were playing in the park with the ball.

describe an action in the past that was happening when another action took place

Examples:



Rina was washing the dishes when the phone rang.



John was reading a book while Mary was watching television.
