
#### **AT A GLANCE**

Adjectives are words that describe the color, number, size and quality of the nouns and pronouns they qualify. They are also used to compare two or more people, animals, places or things.

They live in a **beautiful** house.

She has a cute baby.

Ben is an adorable child.

When there are two or more adjectives of the same group, a comma is used, and the word and is placed between the last two adjectives. A comma is never placed between an adjective and a noun.
